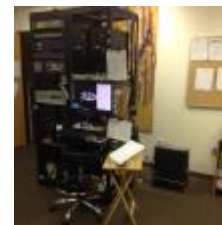
### New Equipment for a New Studio

#### A Message from KGLP's Station Manager

KGLP has relied on community volunteers and students for its operations and local programming ever since the station first went on the air in 1992. While automation has eased the demands of 24/7 operations, making it possible for KGLP to sound like a much bigger public radio station with far fewer folks pushing the buttons, we still believe that community and student involvement is essential to our overall community outreach, and to sharing news and

discussion pertinent to our listening community through this venue owned and operated by the non-profit Gallup Public Radio, Inc.

The radio production facilities provided to Gallup Public Radio by the University of New Mexico Gallup (UNMG) branch campus has made KGLP a living entity over the years, as alive as our supporters and volunteers can make it each day.

Recently, UNMG's now-retiring CFO, Tim Martin, updated figures quantifying how valuable UNMG's in-kind contribution of studio space, electricity, internet access, and other campus services would be on the open market: Nearly \$81,000, annually. This figure,

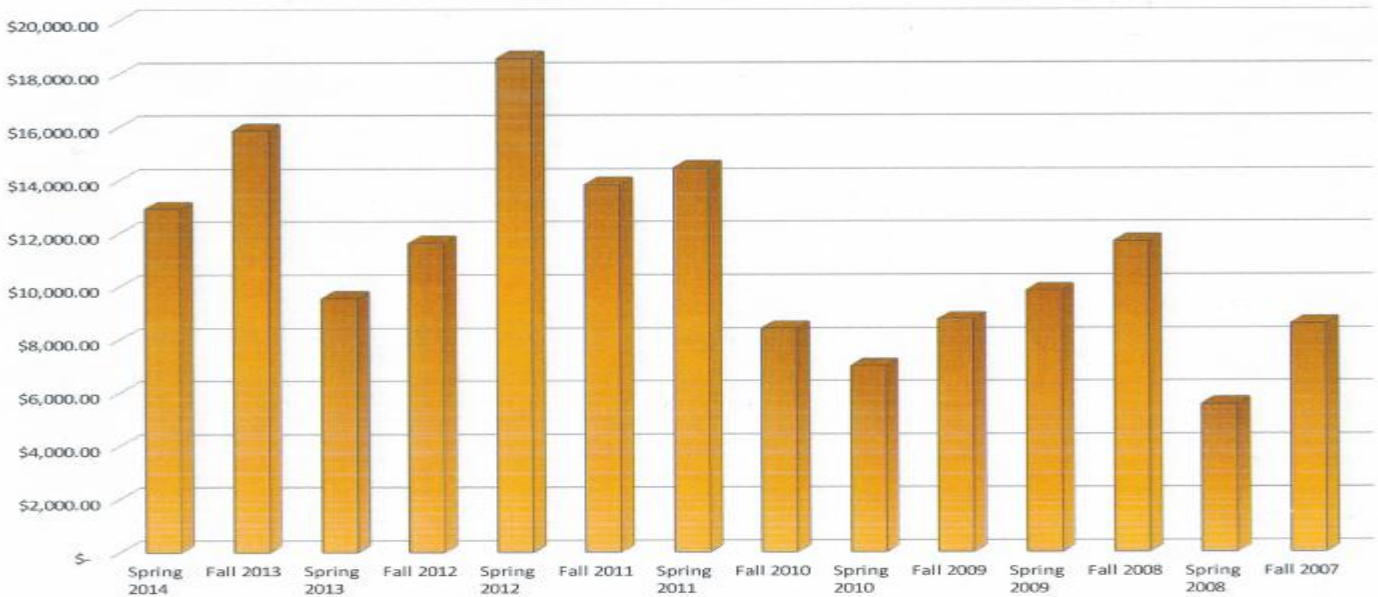

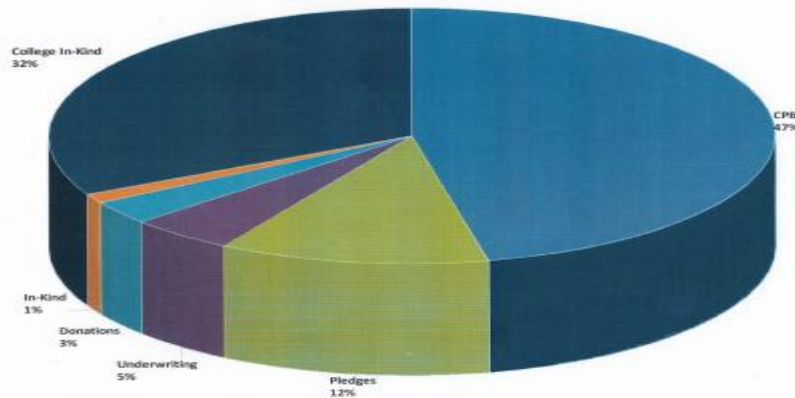

Spring 2014 fundraiser results were up from Spring 2013, if less than last Fall. It is important to note that success in obtaining outside funding is directly tied to our local fundraising success. CPB, for example, specifically requires adequate local funding in order to qualify for grants that help pay for our network programs from NPR, NV1, Pacifica Radio, American Public Media, Public Radio International, and more. UNMG evaluated its in-kind contributions, which helped to more accurately demonstrate this local support to CPB. Every donation from our listener-subscribers also helps us show this. Our goal for the Fall 2014 fundraising campaign, including the on-air fundraising week of October 20, is \$16,000.

Vehicle donations still help immensely. If you have an old vehicle, consider giving it to KGLP (details at KGLP.org). KGLP depends on listener support as much as ever, as we replace worn out equipment or add program services.

KGLP received a \$2,500 grant from the BNSF Railway Foundation this summer, to be applied toward outfitting of the new studio carved out of what used to be KGLP's office, next door to our suite in Gurley Hall, B-212. That former office space is now part of KGLP's suite. The space, which I'll call "Studio B", is somewhat sound-buffered against outside noise, and at this point is likely to become a quieter studio than our current "on-air" studio, which I'll call "Studio A", which we also hope to upgrade with a new audio console and microphones. We don't expect to buy the most expensive equipment on the market. In fact, the consoles that we are looking at are one fourth to one half of the cost, at about \$4,000 each, of the higher-end mixers. With good microphones, we believe that our on-air sound and general audio quality will be noticeably improved.

The estimated cost to outfit "Studio B" is \$10,000, with another \$6,000 estimated to outfit "Studio A" with a new console and microphones. We may be able to use old

cabinetry in "Studio B", to keep the costs down...the audio equipment is the most important part of the new studio at this time, though we'll accept free carpentry!

Thus, during the on-air fundraiser happening October 20 through October 25, we will ask for your support as we reach for and perhaps exceed a Fall 2014 fundraising goal of \$16,000. We will urge contributions in any amount, and hope that those who can afford to give more will make up for those cannot give at all, but rely on KGLP's programs.

There will be premiums such as Be Sargent's landscape paintings, to the first donors of \$300 or more who claim such; or CDs from Eddie Cotton, The Bob Lanza Blues Band, and others, for a donation of \$25 each. And, of course, we have the usual logo pens, soda cozies, and mini-flying discs, as well as Day Sponsorships for those donating \$200 or more. Help us equip KGLP's studios: Help us improve our service to you and your community.
