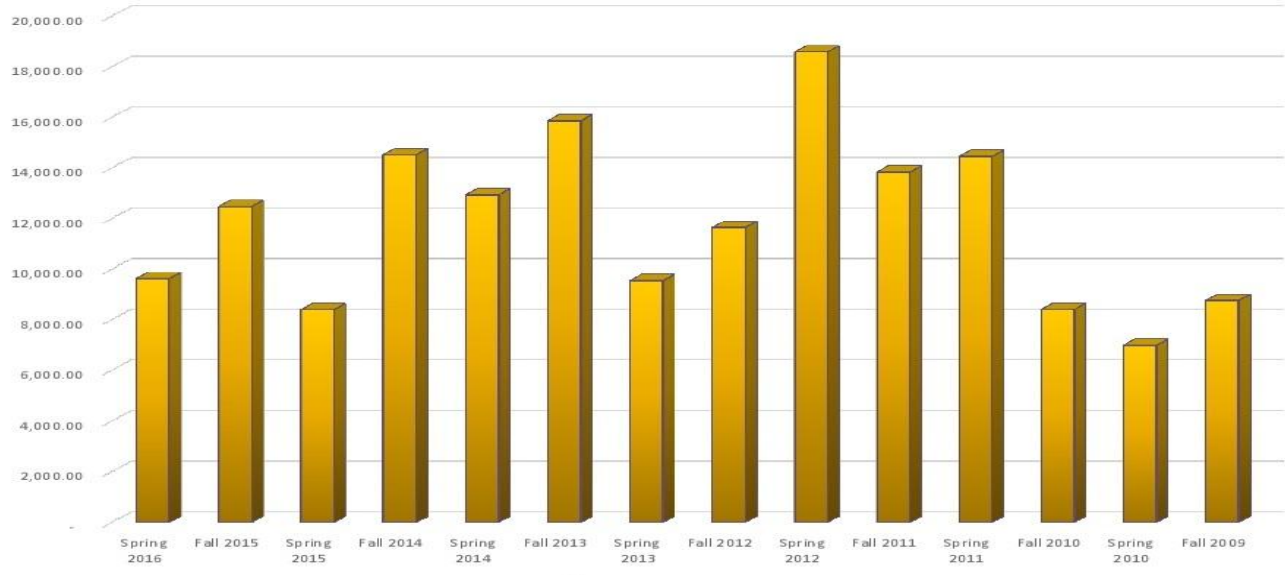

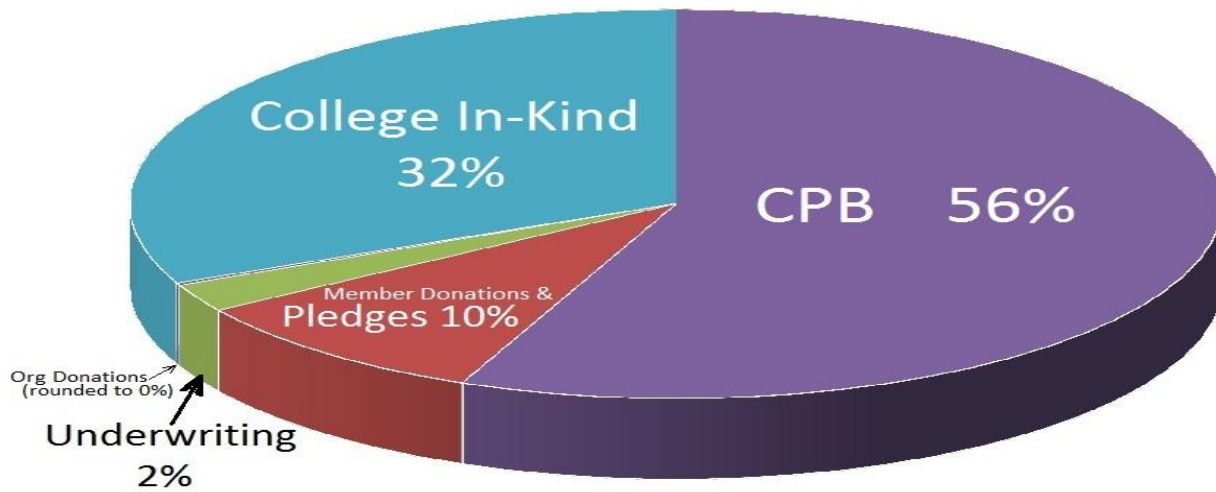

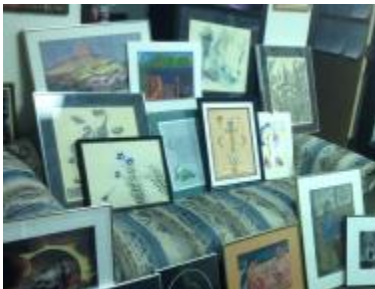

A Message from KGLP's Station Manager

The September 28th Fundraising Soireé sets us on the path to KGLP's Fall Campaign, which officially begins with the week of on-air fundraising Monday, October 17th through Saturday, October 22nd. By year's end, we hope to raise at least \$16,000.

The future of public radio in Gallup, New Mexico, and the surrounding area is stable, but we can never become too complacent about the status of KGLP, with all of the ramifications of political upheaval and increasing strictures. In this coming Spring of 2017, KGLP will apply for the renewal of our license with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), and begin to maintain our public inspection file online, meaning that anyone can view these critical documents without having to come down to the station.

We have been posting our music playlists online for several years now, have copies of annual financials and our diversity policy up at KGLP.org, and archive many of our local interviews and other recorded segments on our podcast page at the website. More and more of Gallup's and KGLP's goings on may not only be heard over the air, but can be further explored through the internet. On KGLP.org, you can donate with PayPal, download a pledge form, donate a vehicle, and shop on Amazon Smile, with a percentage of your purchases donated back to KGLP.

You can listen to KGLP on computers and mobile devices, follow a link to our Facebook page, where more recent updates can be found, and sometimes learn a little more about our neck of the woods (or our neck of the red rocks, as the case may be!)

Our second studio, outfitted with a low-cost mixer, computer, and microphones, plus an old turntable and CD player, is often used for recording and training of students and volunteers, especially important when the on-air studio is in use for live broadcast. We still hope to find funding for enough equipment to not only upgrade our on-air studio, but to

duplicate those broadcast functions in our second studio, for contingency and flexibility.

We are nibbling away at the digitizing of our CD library with the assistance of folks such as Ivah Benally, Strider Brown, Trey Chavez, and Kealey Collison, who has been coming in several times each week for some months to record public service announcements, load CD's into our automation system, and learn a bit about producing audio. Moving audio from CD's into our automation PC's is somewhat tedious, and while I am looking for cost-effective alternatives, manual loading is usually the best way to ensure the quality of the audio and the information that goes with it. Many CD's given to KGLP by musicians are home-burned, with limited metadata, if any, meaning that manual entry of the artist, album, song titles, label, and release date is necessary.

Once enough CD audio is uploaded and available for playback with our "live-assist" mode of the automation system, accommodation of physical limitations will be enhanced. Someone who has limited range of motion can then access the same audio via a keyboard, mouse, voice command, or, with suitable technology, via eye-tracking. I have been exploring the possible use of haptic technology, allowing visually challenged operators to "read" our audio levels using varying degrees of vibration. With suitable consoles, and perhaps something as simple as bluetooth technology, I believe that it is possible to design a cost-effective approach that can not only be prototyped at KGLP, but can then be made available to media outlets throughout the world. Perhaps crowdfunding or grant funds might help achieve the goal of outfitting our studios, when justified by the potential of affordable accommodation for those members of our community whose voices can be heard more effectively when they are empowered to produce radio themselves, rather than relying on a dedicated engineer to serve as their assistant in their communications journey.

As I get older, my mobility and vision will continue to diminish, as is the case with many of my friends and associates in the Gallup area and around the world. Some are never blessed with the full range of motion and senses that we might have taken for granted during our youth.

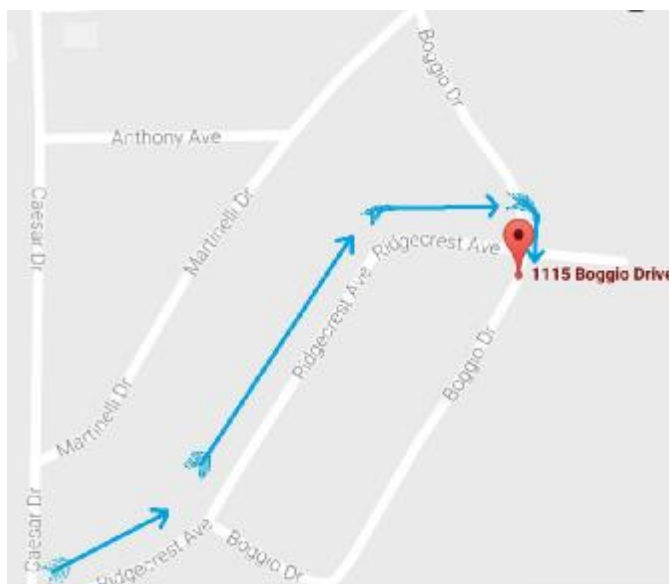
