occasionally, we've noticed that KGLP's signal is experiencing pops, clicks, or dropouts that we can't blame on our tidy little transmitter.

Instead, we believe that the issue is our aging STL, which conveys audio, via micro-wave, from the roof of UNM-Gallup's Gurley Hall (KGLP's studios are in the basement) up to the Gibson Peak transmitter site, about 16 miles and 2,000 feet up from the campus. A new STL runs \$25k.

We appreciate all of our listeners, and certainly our supporters, including those of you who donate to KGLP repeatedly, once or twice a year, and those who have become sustaining members, arranging for automatic donations of smaller amounts each month.

We hope that you'll join us at Dr. Sloan's house on Thursday, October 10, 2019, any time between 6:30 and 9pm, when we'll have classical music performed by local musician and teacher Liam Murphy, while you might sample Salmon, wine, cheese, and other refreshments. We do hope that you'll bring your check book, too! This event kicks off our Fall Campaign.

KGLP has now been airing programs in Gallup, New Mexico, and the surrounding area for over 27 years, with the help of many supporters for over two and a half decades, including most of you who are reading this, now.

We'll continue with our Fall / Winter Campaign through New Year's Eve, hoping again for more of you to become sustaining members, signing up online for monthly donations through credit, PayPal, or bank transfer, to serve our listeners, the community of Gallup and surrounding areas such as Bread Springs, Churchrock, Tohatchi, Houck, Thoreau, and parts of other communities such as Window Rock, Ft. Defiance, St. Michaels, Ramah, and Zuni.

Cash flow has always been important, as provided by our donors and members. Additionally, our funding from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting is contingent on sufficient matching funds, such as from our listeners. You help sustain our grant funding with every dollar given to Gallup Public Radio.

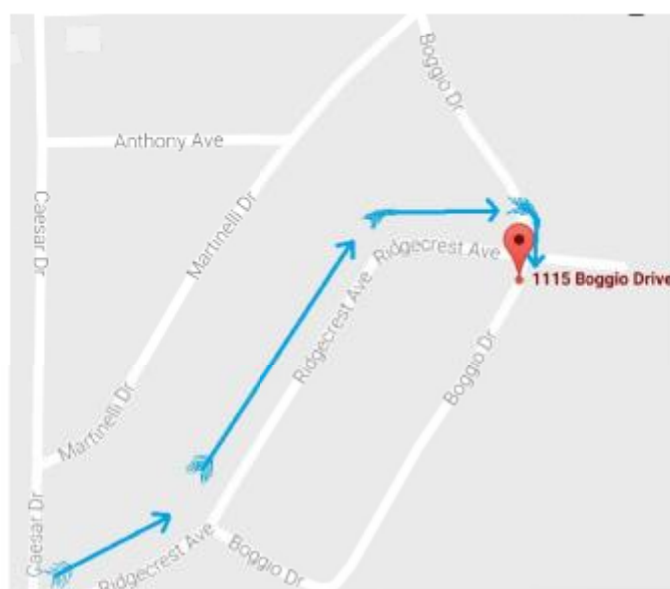
