#### A Message from KGLP's Station Manager

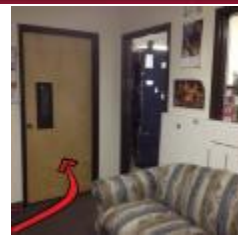

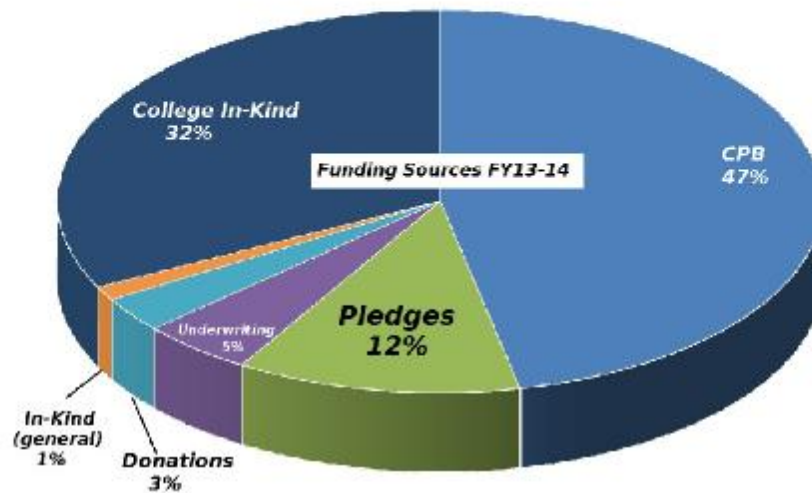
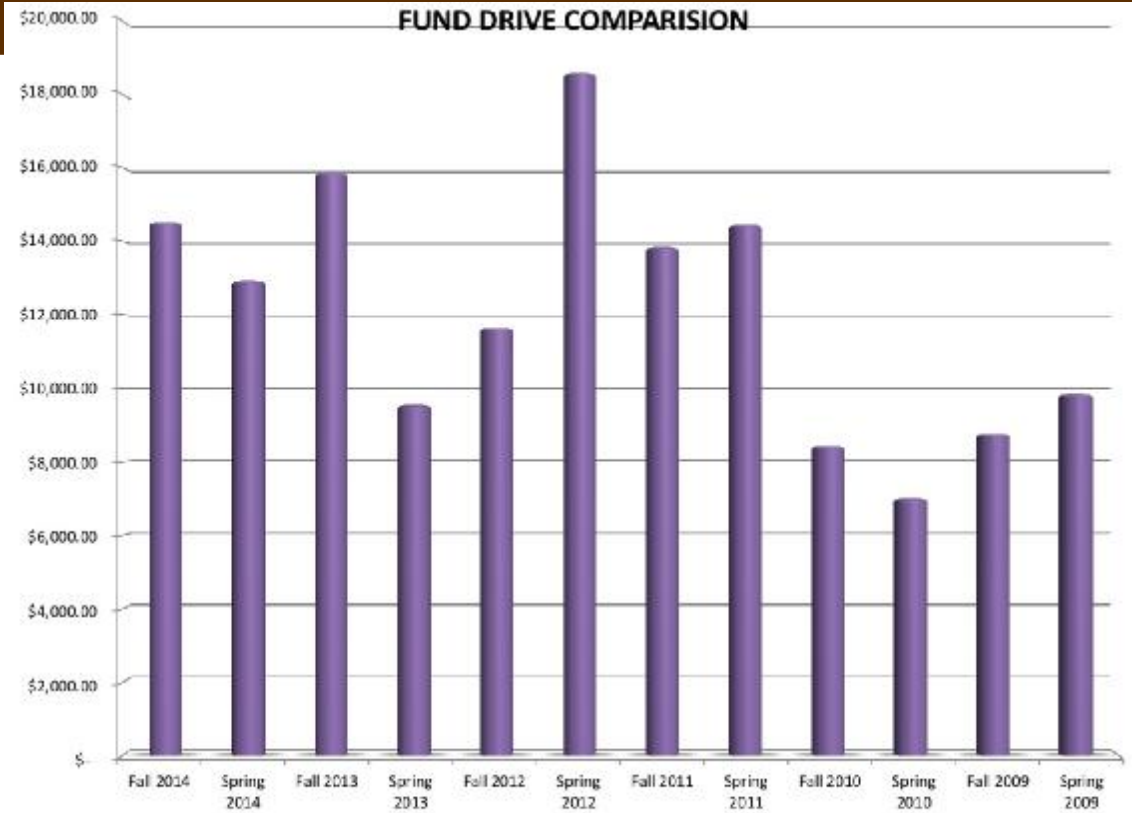

## *a Message From KGLP's Manager* (continued from Page 1)

Clear Channel provides KGLP tower and transmitter space at their Gibson Peak facility, also for a very nominal cost. UNM-Gallup provides space for KGLP's studios. These community partners have been indispensable in keeping KGLP on the air, as is everyone who donates anything toward the continuation of this service. The BNSF Railway Foundation kicked in \$2,500 for use in the construction of our second studio, now in development (we're still accepting donations for the project, but hope to begin purchasing equipment for a full implementation of that recording and broadcast space soon.)

We've lost partners and associates, too. Several members of the UNM-Gallup campus passed in the last few months, as well as some friends of KGLP, including Dr. Teresa Wilkins, Dr. Mark Wilson, Dr. Ralph Casebolt, former Gallup resident and author Susan Klopfer, and several family members of other UNMG faculty and staff.

We have a few copies left of Susan's audiobook, "Who Killed Emmett Till", an investigation into the backstory of a 14-year-old's murder in Mississippi, said by some to be a

pivotal moment behind the inception of the modern Civil Rights movement in the United States. Susan had given KGLP these audiobooks for use as premiums, and we hope that those of you who have never heard this remarkable CD set will acquire a copy during our pledge drive.

We may have some artwork to offer from local treasure Be Sargent, as well as some other gifts and premiums, while they last. We were running low on bumper stickers, so have ordered some more, this time in a Maroon tone, as displayed on page 1 of this newsletter.

Our Fall 2014 fundraiser was successful, though we were about \$1,500 short of our \$16,000 goal...We'll try again for \$16,000 in pledges this time around.

One programming note: Isla Earth has ended production, and so we will be rotating other features into each weekday afternoon, along with some archival Isla Earth features for good measure. Thank you for listening!
